

NDSCS TRAINING ROOM RULES

1. The Athletic Training Room is a medical facility, and should be treated as such. Proper behavior, attire, and language will be required at all times. Failure to follow these standards will result in removal from the Athletic Training Room
2. All athletes will sign in for all services received in the Athletic Training Room, examples are taping, modality treatments, rehabilitation
3. No cell phone use in the Athletic Training Room. Use of headphones is also limited, volume must be at a reasonable level, and use must not distract from the treatment/rehabilitation session
4. No athletes will be allowed in the Athletic Trainers office without supervision from Athletic Trainer
5. No athletes will be allowed to take supplies from cabinets or drawers if a supply is not on the taping station you need to ask for assistance
6. Athletes should leave all equipment, books, and coats in locker room
7. Athletes will not place shoes on tables, chairs, or countertops
8. Training room towels will not be allowed to leave the Training Room. Athletes are responsible for bringing their own towel for whirlpool treatments.
9. Athletes will not be taped on practice or game field/court. Taping/ wound care should be done in the Athletic Training Room before practice or contests.
10. Athletes must be signed out for all braces, wraps, and Training Room supplies/equipment. If athlete does not return the supply they will be charged replacement costs.
11. No athletes will be allowed to remove supplies/equipment from the Head Athletic Trainers kit without permission.
12. Modality treatments are given as part of treatment protocol or by physician orders. The Head Athletic Trainer will determine which treatments are appropriate, and necessary.
